Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope that 2019 will be a year of blessings for your church community.

The NBA continues to offer opportunities for those serving in the local church to receive training in safeguarding. This training helps everyone to understand how to work safely and how to recognise and respond appropriately to the safeguarding needs of the church community. BUGB recommends that training is undertaken at least once every four years.

Level 2 is for the minister, deacons/trustees, the Designated Person for Safeguarding and all those who do work in your church with children, young people or adults. These sessions take place on 9th March (Billingham) and 16th March (Beacon Lough). Places can be booked now on the attached booking form.

Level 3 will be offered later in the year on 22nd June (Billingham) and 6th July (Beacon Lough) This is for the minister, deacons/trustees, the Designated Person for Safeguarding and any others in relevant leadership roles, all of whom should have already completed Level 2.

Ministers can choose to attend a combined Level 2/3 session for ministers only that will be held later in the year on 24th September (Durham). For anyone unable to attend the spring/summer sessions, a combined Level2/3 session will be held on 12th October (venue tba).

Please think carefully about who in your church needs to attend.
