Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We hope that 2020 has started well for your church community.

As usual, we are offering opportunities for those working in our churches to receive training in safeguarding, which BUGB recommends is undertaken at least once every four years.

Level 2 is for the minister, deacons/trustees, the Designated Person for Safeguarding and all those who work in your church with children, young people or adults. These sessions take place on 28th March (Beacon Lough, trainer Lynn Fletcher) and 25th April (Portrack, trainer JanTurner). Places can be booked now on the attached booking form.

Level 3 will be offered later in the year on 13th June (Beacon Lough) and 4th July (Portrack). This is for the minister, deacons/trustees, the Designated Person for Safeguarding and any others in relevant leadership roles, all of whom should have already completed Level 2.

Ministers can choose to attend a combined Level 2/3 session for ministers only that will be held 29th September (Durham).

For anyone unable to attend the spring/summer sessions, a combined Level 2&3 session will be held on 10th October (venue tba).

Please think carefully about who in your church needs to attend. We would love to see churches sending groups of people, who can not only learn together but also go on to support each other in maintaining excellent safeguarding practice in their church.
