Dear Minister

Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whose name we care for and safeguard all those He brings to our churches.

As you are aware, the undertaking of Safeguarding Training is a requirement for all Baptist Union Accredited Ministers and needs to be updated every four years.

Given the responsibilities of ministry in teaching, leading, pastoral care and other roles, it is vital that ministers access training at both Level 2 and Level 3. This training covers the safeguarding of adults at risk of abuse (vulnerable adults) as well as the safeguarding of children and young people. In addition, by being trained on safe working practices, we protect ourselves against unwise behaviour on our part and against allegations of abuse.

By combining Level 2 and Level 3 training into one session, including lunch, on a week day, we hope that this training will be accessible to you and give you an opportunity to learn alongside and fellowship with your colleagues in the region.
